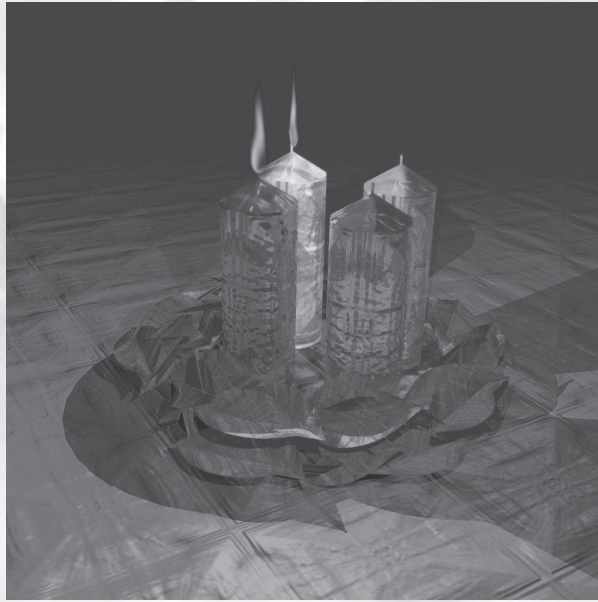

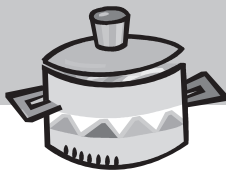
New Choir CD

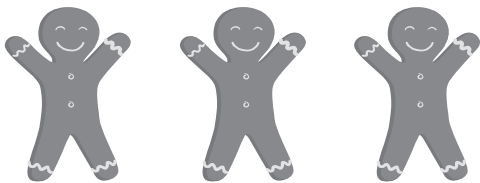
Need Pots & Pans
