we supply between 750-1,000 people with a week's worth of food, and keeping our shelves stocked this time of year is a HUGE challenge!

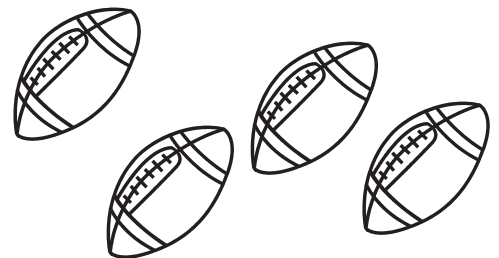

Restore Omaha Historic Restoration Tour

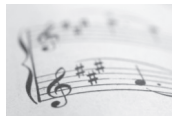
