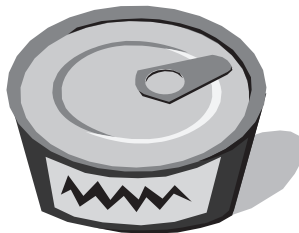


Fall Food Drive

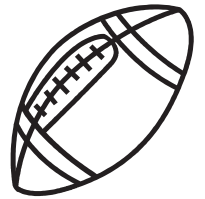


Revenue needed each week

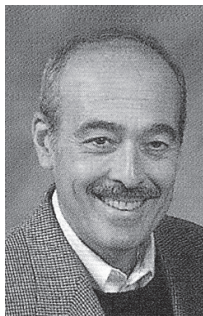
