## Parishioners Help

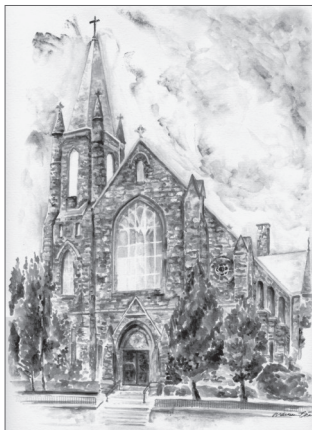
